Greetings,

The Kurds today face the most difficult moment of their history in Iraq. The experience of coexistence in Iraq has failed because violations of Iraqi Constitution. In the past decade or so, successive regimes in Baghdad have ignored to stipulate several important articles of the constitution. Here, I would like to draw your attention to all abuses of 55 key constitution articles which have been violated by Baghdad.

What the Kurds are demanding in Iraq is a right of being treated equally and respectfully. While our rights have been overlooked and neglected for racist reasons by militias and officials in Iraq, we ask the international community to play their parts. We believe the respected representatives of international communities, Embassies and Consulate in Baghdad and Erbil and all Government authorities around the world have the duty to understand the situation and the context in which how Kurdistan's rights within the constitution had been ignored.

Thus, I would like to send you the attached document which highlights violations of the Iraqi Constitution by Baghdad. I hope this document, which is carefully studied by a team of impartial legal experts, will help you to understand the reasons for current political tension and discord between Baghdad and Erbil.
